Canton Connection *by John Tscholl*

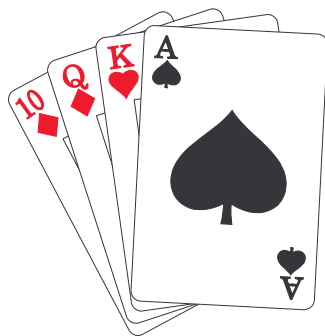
Our Unit recently held a Standard American Yellow Card individual game. Playing with 24 different partners was truly a unique experience. The majority of players attending the game declared that they had an enjoyable evening but would not want to make a habit of playing only one hand with each partner. Although everyone in the room was playing the same convention card, the contracts reached on individual hands varied widely due to the player's personal views of their respective card holdings (just like in a regular duplicate game). Witness the following hand played by **Sparky Kolp** (my partner at the time):

I opened the North hand one spade, East passed, Sparky bid two hearts, West called three diamonds and after that the bidding on both sides of the table just more or less took off until Sparky ended up in six hearts doubled by East who had jumped to six diamonds along the way.

In defense of my subsequent bidding to slam, I must confess that I'm used to 2/1 and was counting on some cards in Sparky's hand.

West dutifully let a club in response to his partner's Lightner double (probably illegal in SAYC but nobody noticed until after the evening was over and several of the hands were being discussed). East ruffed the club but that was the defense's only trick as the major suit Kings were favorably located and Sparky chalked up his doubled slam contract. Whew!

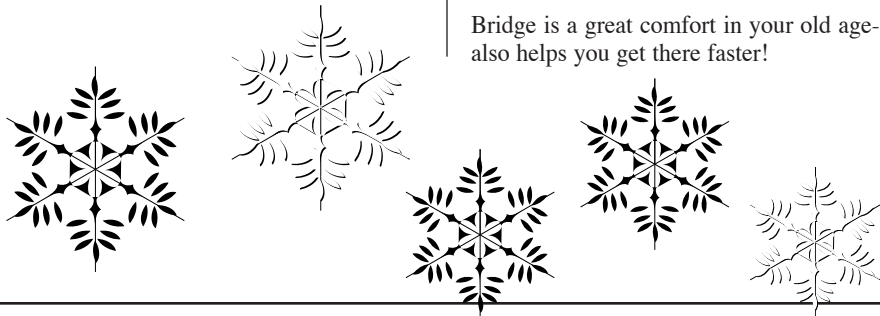
There have been 2 rank changes reported- **Beth Anderson** is an NABC Master & **Andrea Leonardi** is a Club Master. Keep moving onward!
