**A STaC is a Sectional  
Tournament at Clubs.**

**This is how it works:**

A STaC is essentially a SECTIONAL Tournament except that the individual sections of the SECTIONAL take place at individual clubs, at or about the same time, instead of together at one large location. Every game at every participating club you attend during STaC Week may be part of the tournament. The results of the game you play in will be combined with the results from all of the other clubs playing at the same time and one giant OVERALL will be tallied. Let's say that Olean, Canton, Greensburg, Cumberland and Parkersburg are all playing at the same time. Scoring is first done on a club-by-club basis and SILVER points awarded for each section. Then the results of all four games are combined as if everyone were playing under one roof. Highest percentage score is first overall, next is second overall, and so forth. Because you are competing against so many people, you can earn a lot of points. All of them, whether they are section awards or overall awards, will be SILVER. Yes, it will cost a little more to play in a STaC game. ACBL sanction fees are higher and a director must be paid to coordinate the gathering and issuing of points.

## TABLE TACTICS

Sometimes the best tactic is to Pass over opponent's Takeout Double of partner's opening bid. Listen to what the other opponent has to bid. Don't be afraid the double will stand. There is no reason to bid quickly. At the one level, it is rare that the opponents can take seven tricks to set partner especially if you have a three card fit with partner's opening suit. Your left-hand opponent will scramble in response to his partner's Double and your initial pass. By passing first and listening to the following bids, you'll have a better opportunity to assess the situation and visualize the opponents' card holdings. Another bonus, partner may be able to make a second bid further describing his or her hand. Then, at your turn, come into the bidding with a more educated call which may include a pass. If you bid, partner may be surprised to hear from you, but will be able to trust your bid because you have taken the time to better judge the situation.

## Pittsburgh Potpourri *by Mary Anne McNeirney*

Our city is dealing with a great sadness now. Our friend, **Myron Cope**, has died. He was the voice of Pittsburgh sports and the city itself for the last 40 years. His legacy demands a special "Myron, 'yo!! Double Yo." He made our Pittsburgh accent a recognizable and charming part of Americana. People throughout the country I've encountered in my bridge travels often told me that when they first heard his voice they cringed at its rasp and his expressions, but they often ended up imitating him in a friendly fashion. At least 5 told me that he was the finest football airways communicator in the business. He did much to develop concepts of the Steeler Nation and our pride in the city itself. His creation of the "Terrible Towel" cemented these ideas in all us Burghers. His donation of all the profits of the Towel and any other merchandise it generates to the Autism Foundations for research, care, treatment, and housing for

autistic sufferers, made us appreciate him even more. He was a real friend to our town. He had very strong associations to our bridge world; his sister **Shirley Meyers**, and his niece, **Devera Meyers**, are both avid participants in our bridge wars. Dev, as Myron once did, writes for the POST GAZETTE. She is presently researching bridge in its South Hills.
