District Votes on Charitable Donations

The ACBL Charity Foundation has made \$30,000 available this year for our District to pass out to local charities. It is part of a program to make Charity Foundation monies available, on a rotating basis, to serve the areas where bridge players live. We were allowed to distribute \$20,000 in 2005 and that amount grew as a result of the extra "special games" run in ACBL.

It was announced at the May District Board Meeting that suggestions would be solicited from all over the District and voted on at the District Board Meeting in Pittsburgh over the Labor Day weekend. We had 13 suggestions for recipients submitted to the District for voting at the meeting.

We now have 6 charities who are going to receive \$5000 each as soon as they submit the 501 (c)3 paperwork from the Internal Revenue Service because if it isn't a 501 (c)3, the ACBL Charity Foundation cannot give them money. We are confident that these charities will qualify.

The charities that your delegates to the meeting chose were: The Lawrence County (PA) Association for Retarded Citizens to provide housing for the mentally retarded; The Family and Community Services, Inc. of Portage County (OH) that provides referrals and volunteers to meet the various needs of the area people; The Sigal Family Research and Education IBD Fund at the University of Pittsburgh (ACBL Member Founded) which raises money for research on inflammatory bowel disease; The Little Portion Friary of Buffalo New York which provides temporary housing and services for the homeless; The Empty Bowl Project (founded by an ACBL member) that benefits the Westmoreland County Food bank; and Stewart's Caring Place of Akron that provides support and services to cancer patients.

Thank you for your suggestions and your contributions. That extra dollar you contribute for that charity game at your local club is really making a difference right here at home.

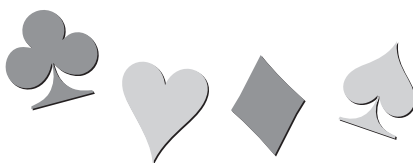
