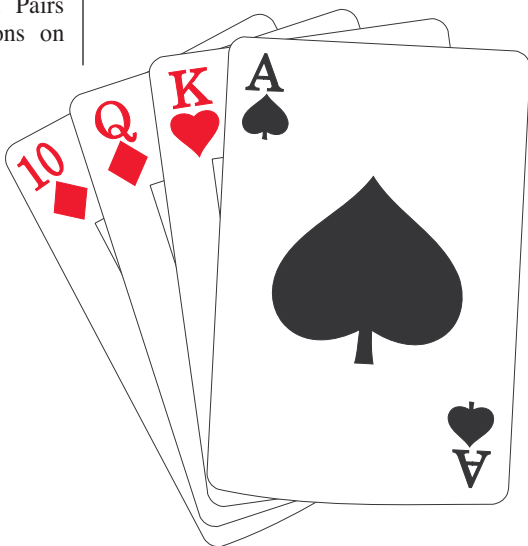
Springtime Sectional March 4-6 –
