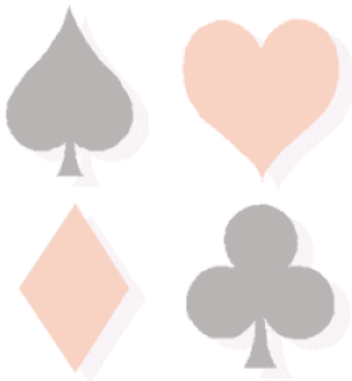
Nationals in Toronto. I hope all of the players from our area who attended had good luck!

North American Pairs (NAP) Qualifier – The Friday Game will hold its last Qualifiers for the North American Pairs (NAP) on August 12 and August 26 at 12:30 p.m. at the Quirk Center. Those who qualify will be eligible to compete in the District 5 finals be held in Meadville on October 22 and 23. District winners will compete in the ACBL Finals at the Spring 2012 NABC in Memphis.

Bridge Teams League – The four night Fall Team League starts September 16. The other nights will be October 21, November 11 and December 16. All the matches will be played at 7:30 at the Quirk Center in Cuyahoga Falls. This TEAM LEAGUE event, however, will use the “Eight is Enough” format. Teams must be made up so the team total is no more than eight points; where A players (1500 or more master points) are 3 points, B players (500 to 1500 master points) are 2 points, and C players (0 to 500 master points) are 1 point. Teams will be placed in brackets based on the ACBL masterpoints of the four highest team members. All matches will be handicapped based on the player used for each match. The handicap for each match will be assigned based upon the ACBL published team handicap table.
